

Do It Thyself

Thoughts on a Honey and Salt Scrub

Lady Aine of Phoenix Glade

Bathing practices throughout history have been varied, but sometimes a basic idea is just too good to let go fully. Salt has served many purposes, including hygiene and wound care, with the first recorded accounting coming from China circa 2700 BCE. This is a wonderful justification for the classic 'I just want to' logic I actually had in my heart when I tried this recipe. The base recipe was:

2 cups olive oil

2/3 cup honey

½ teaspoon grapefruit essential oil

1/4 teaspoon bergamot essential oil

3 cups salt

Sugar (optional)

I first mixed the oil, honey, and essential oils. Next, add the salt in half cup increments until you achieve a texture that is mostly like a wet sand with most liquid absorbed but some not for maintaining the proper texture. Ultimately, I wound up using four cups of salt and one cup of sugar to achieve this. I jarred the salt and left the excess oil in my mixing bowl to add the cup of sugar, topping the jars off with that and the excess oil required. If you enjoy a light scent, the amount of essential oils is sufficient, but if you prefer a stronger scent, add more essential oils in ¼ teaspoon increments.

For things to try differently next time, I would focus on using a lighter scented oil, olive oil is not bad, this is a matter of preference and having a sensitive nose. I would additionally like to try a half and half mix of sugar and salt to see if the texture is better. The salt required a lot more incorporation to achieve a good texture, whereas the cup of sugar used incorporated more easily, and there is perfection somewhere in the middle.

Once this is prepared to your satisfaction, apply to damp skin to help with body exfoliation, but this is far too coarse for your face. Use within four months or assess for mold and throw away at your discretion.

Clary Sage

Throughout history, spring has had many meanings and markers. From marking the beginning of the new year to marking the beginning of lambing season, one consistency is the preparing and planting the next season's plants. Outside of fields for crops, there were also kitchen gardens that contained culinary and medicinal herbs and spices. One plant that could be found throughout many time periods and locations is at least one variety of sage, commonly clary sage (Salvia sclarea). Sage started appearing in writings as early as the 4th century BCE from Theophrastus, with many uses noted. A popular use was for nerves, used as the sensors around the body, and a general cure-all. (Walker 2013, 83) Ingested in tea or posset drink, the leaves and flowers are usable plant parts. Hildegard von Bingen in *Physica* suggests using sage mixed with garlic, chervil, and vinegar as a condiment to assist in encouraging appetite in someone who struggles with hunger. There were also less palatable to modern sensibilities remedies. In A Choice Manual of Rare and Select Secrets in Physick and Chyrurgery, those seeking relief for any ache in the joints, sciatica, diseases of the sinews, and pains of the reins and back are directed to take various parts of a fox or badger, combine it with various oils, waters, sage and other herbs, strained to create lineaments for the previously mentioned afflictions. Modernly, clary sage maintains its usefulness in muscatel flavoring and essential oils. Clary sage is hardy in zones 5-9, which includes the Barony of Wintermist. It may be planted in the fall in the warmer areas, but only the spring in colder climates; however, the plants will not flower until the spring regardless. It is a biennial plant, meaning it lives for two years, one year for growth and the second for the flowering and harvest. It requires well-draining soil and medium moisture to flourish. Clary sage is considered self-sowing, so leave a few flowers to seed and you will have an unending cycle of sage in your garden. To practice responsible gardening, ensure that any outdoor plants are not considered invasive before introducing them, clary sage is considered an invasive noxious weed in Idaho and areas of Washington. Southern California does contain clary sage, with pretty purple flowers and functioning as a deer-deterrent, this plant may be a good fit for your garden.
